Ambassador Volunteers are our most experienced and trusted representatives who speak at events, engage with donors, and advocate for Hope's Promise in the community. These volunteers are typically board members or long-time supporters who embody our mission and values and are confident speaking on our behalf.

Requirements:

- Pass background checks
- Attend an agency orientation
- Complete specialized training in public speaking and organizational representation
- Demonstrated history of support for Hope's Promise

Once accepted into the program, volunteers will:

- Receive a monthly email highlighting upcoming volunteer opportunities
- Be contacted directly for special volunteer requests that match their interests and skills
- Become part of a community of caring individuals dedicated to our mission
